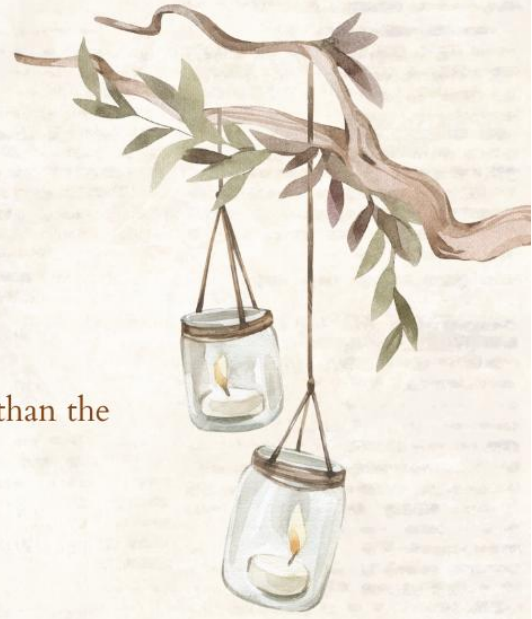

Arrival



Before

- To get a visa, you first need a reference number. (VGU will help you with that.)
- Inform VGU about your length of stay during the application (especially if the period is shorter/longer than the semester).
- Provide the required documents at least 12 weeks before arrival via the form provided.
- Make sure your passport is valid for at least 12 months upon arrival in Vietnam.
- Your reference number shall be sent to you at least 30 days before your arrival.
- Diplomatic missions are in Frankfurt and in Berlin (in Germany) or in your country of residence.

After

- Make sure you get a student visa (DH), not a tourist one (DL) by making sure that the officer stamps you the correct visa type “DH” which is issued for study purpose. (Check at the Embassy/Diplomatic Unit where the visa is issued).
- Further guidelines and highlights regarding visa receipt can be sent out to you once your visa reference number has been issued.

Maybe you should know before arrival:

- Please check information on the website of your Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Passport valid for at least 6 months upon entry. Fly into Tan Son Nhat International Airport (SGN).
- Prohibited: Drugs, weapons, explosives, pornographic/anti-government content
- Restricted: Drones, large medical devices, professional filming gear
- Declare if carrying over USD 5,000 or gold/jewelry not for personal use
- No mandatory vaccines, but there are dengue and malaria infections all over Vietnam transmitted by mosquitoes. Please prepare yourself against unwanted mosquito bites (mosquito net, insect repellent, malaria prophylaxis etc.).
- Immigration procedures may take 30–60 minutes, depending on the time of arrival and the number of incoming flights.



Maybe you should know before arrival:

- Exchange currency– Vietnamese đồng (VND) is the local currency. Refer to Monetary Transaction for obtaining this. We recommend you get some at the airport (about 5.000.000 VND or 200 EUR). Credit cards accepted in most hotels/shops. Can open a local bank account (for long-term stays): Passport, visa, proof of residence/employment required.
- SIM cards are readily available from major providers such as **Viettel**, **Vinaphone**, and **Mobifone**. You can purchase them at the airport or at mobile shops throughout the city. Free Wi-Fi is widely available in cafes, restaurants, hotels, and many public areas, making it easy to stay connected. Note: most apps require a Vietnamese phone number, so you should get one now.
- Translation apps are very helpful, not everyone will understand English. Google Translate is the most popular.
- In order to reach the VGU Campus in Binh Duong (Not Ho Chi Minh City/Saigon), please refer to the Transportation section. We recommend using Grab or Xanh SM, go outside the international terminal and over the crosswalk, and try to find your driver there. You may get scammed if you use an external taxi service that wasn't recommended by us.
- Be sure to arrive before 3pm so you can check into your dorm room on the same day. After you arrive at VGU, be sure to text your Buddy to come pick you up, and show you around.



Arrival at VGU

- Meet us at the International Office at Room 218, 2nd Floor, Admin Building, Binh Duong campus to verify documents, submit pictures of your visa stamp and entry stamp, and get your student ID card, which is a must during your time at the campus.
- If you study at Ho Chi Minh Campus, the student card can be sent to the program assistant for your collection.
- Check in at the Dorm at VGU if you registered to stay at the Dorm, or find accommodation if you will live outside the campus.

Important: According to the current Vietnam immigration Law, a foreigner has to register at the local police station after arrival in Vietnam. If you live at VGU dorm, this will be taken care by VGU Dormitory Management Board, please kindly present your original passport to the dorm officer upon your arrival at the check-in process step. In case you live in a rented accommodation, please ask your landlord to take care of this issue.

The Metro cost a little more, and travels faster.

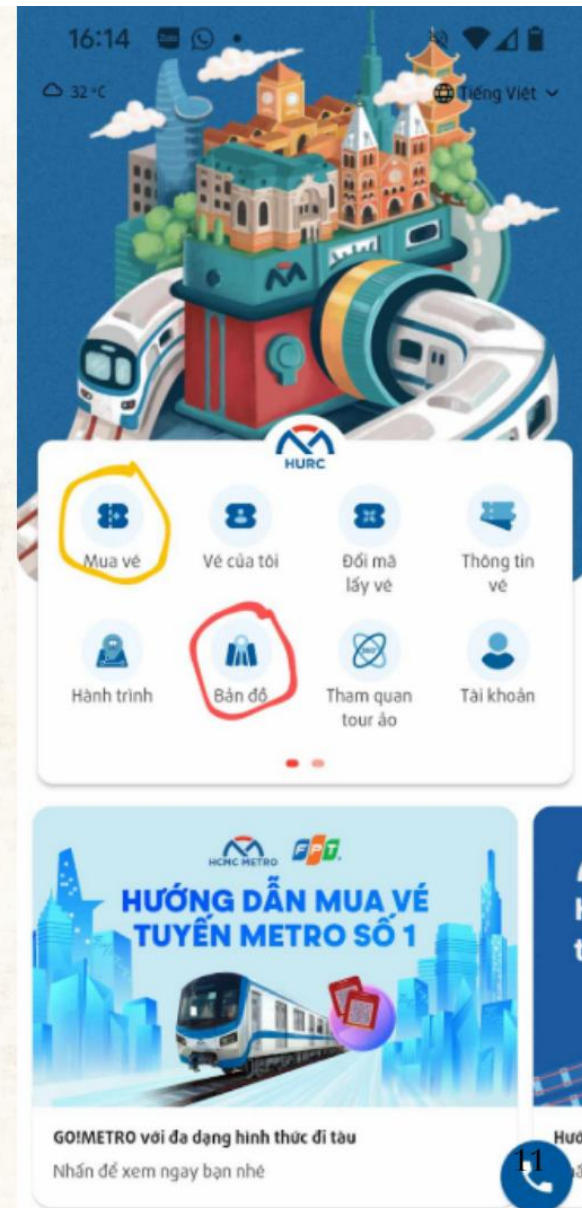

Red is for bus routes.





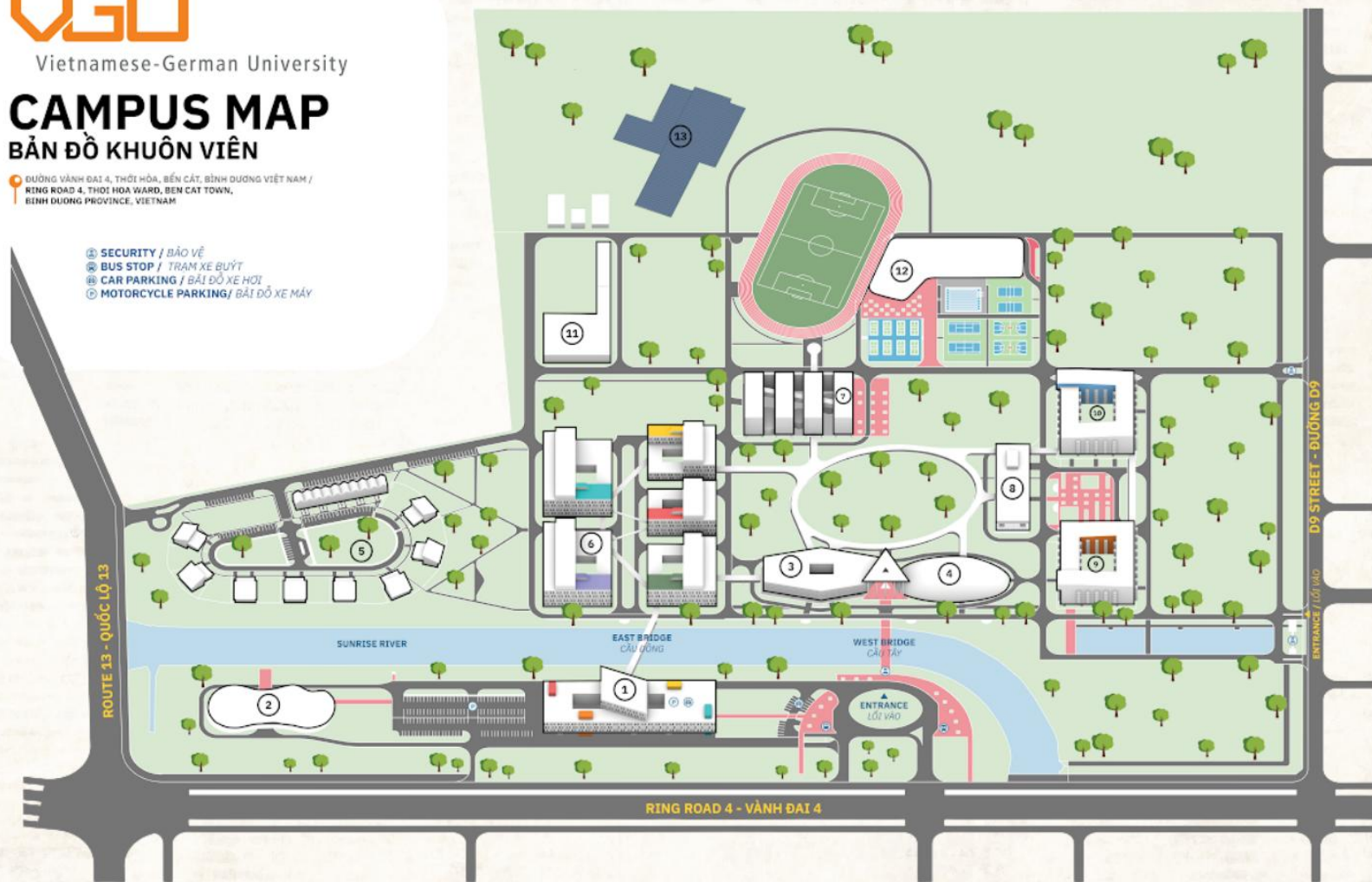

Campus

Please get some detailed pictures of the places im about to list out:

1. Admin building – This is where the International Office is, and you will sometimes have to go here for inquiries outside of the Buddy Program’s scope
3. Library – A study and group work place with plenty of space, TVs, fans and air conditioning. You can sit anywhere, borrow books, use the printing service, use the lockers, or book a room for your studies. It is open from 9am to 10pm, from Monday to Saturday. Please go through this website to fully understand the services: <https://library.vgu.edu.vn/>.
4. Ceremony Hall – Important events will be held here, but you won’t frequent it too much.
5. Academic Village (Villa) – A place to rent out luxurious apartments for a hefty price. Suitable for parties.
6. Academic Cluster – Specialized labs and learning facilities for certain majors.
7. Lecture Hall – Where most of your studies will take place. There are 6 floors in total.
8. Food Court (Cafeteria) – You can purchase warm meals here for lunch, and drinks and some baked goods.
9. Dormitory 1 (Orange) – Communal Kitchens, Convenience Store, Self-study room.
10. Dormitory 2 (Blue) – Communal Kitchens, Medical Room, Dormitory Management, Self-study rooms.
12. Sports Hall – Track Field for running and soccer/disc throwing, Inner stadium for Basketball, rooms for table tennis, tennis and badminton and basketball court, and a pool with an entrance fee of 25.000 VND.

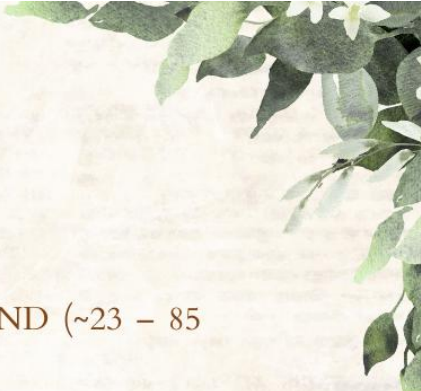


Check Out Process

Living on campus

Rents: We recommend shared double, triple bedrooms and single bedrooms, from 600,000 – 2,400,000 VND (~23 – 85 EUR)/each person. (water and electricity not included)

Food Cost

- Canteen offers breakfast, lunch, dinner from ~ 25,000 VND (~1 EUR)
- 25,000 VND (~1 EUR)/meal at the food street, 50,000 VND (~2 EUR) over Grab food
- 200,000 VND (~8 EUR) for going out and 500,000 VND (~20 EUR) for a week of cooking
- You can wake up right before class, everything academic is in a 10 minute distance; gates close at 11pm, so you cannot exit or enter the campus after that; lacking nightlife; nearest supermarket 3 km away

Bus costs

150,000 VND (~6 EUR) for a one-way trip to Saigon (plus accommodation costs if you want to stay over; usually from 10–20 EUR/room/night)

Extracurricular activities

Outdoor sports (Football, Baseball, Ultimate Frisbee, Running...):

- Tennis courts, basketball courts
- Badminton courts; volleyball court - 01 swimming pool

Indoor: Large sports hall equipped to play a variety of sports (Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton, Futsal)



Living in Thu Dau Mot City

Rents:

- Apartment in the City Centre 5,000,000 VND (~190 EUR) to 10,000,000 VND (~380 EUR)

Food Cost

- A single person estimated monthly costs are about 4,000,000 VND (~160 EUR).

Bus costs (*Registration needed*)

- Daily bus (Becamex – VGU) 3,600,000 VND (~140 EUR)/semester (6 months)
- Weekly bus (Becamex – VGU): 1,900,000 VND (~75 EUR)/semester (6 months)

Day in life

- VGU bus departs at **7.50 am** from Becamex to the campus, wake up early enough to get to station in time.
- Departure at VGU around 4.30 pm and arrival at Becamex around 5 pm.
- Okay nightlife and weekends. Not as crowded as HCMC, yet busy.



Living in Ho Chi Minh City

Rents:

- Apartment (1 bedroom) in City Centre 12,628,778.50 VND (~480 EUR)
- Apartment (1 bedroom) outside of Centre 7,456,835.63 VND (~280 EUR) 1EUR = 30,405.18 (02/06/2025)

Food Cost

- A single person estimated monthly costs are 12,351,538.0 VND (~470 EUR) without rent.
- A traditional meal costs 50,000 VND (~2 EUR) and an restaurant dining about 300,000 VND (~12 EUR) /person.

Bus costs (*Registration needed*)

- Daily bus (Becamex – VGU) 8,500,000 VND (~320 EUR)/semester (6 months)
- Weekly bus (Becamex – VGU): 4,500,000 VND (~170 EUR)/semester(6 months)

Day in life

- VGU bus departs at 6:45 am from Turtle Lake to campus, wake up early enough to get to station on time.
- Departure from VGU at 4.30 pm, arrival in HCM around 6:30 pm.
- Vivid nightlife and weekends. Might be overwhelming at first.

Shopping

Food and beverage:

On campus, the easiest way to get food is the cafeteria, but they don't serve dinner.

If you crave more variety, please head outside the D9 gate and explore the many restaurants they have, both at lunchtime and evening time.

Please explore the other nearby restaurants for other dishes, such as Phở, cơm chiên trứng (egg fried rice), cơm tấm sườn (broken rice with grilled pork), bún thịt nướng (rice noodles with grilled meat), mì cay (spicy noodles), cơm xú mại (rice with meatballs), cơm bò lúc lắc (rice with beef chunks).



Food and beverage:

Street food locations right outside the campus

It takes only 5 minutes to walk out the road next to the campus where you can have plenty of food and beverages options for your daily meals. Most of the places serve traditional dishes such as rice with side dishes, noodles, soup, banh mi and burgers. However, there are limited options for vegans and vegetarians, only upon request to private vendors.

Cafes or juice and tea bars offer a variety of drinks, from fresh pressed juices, coconut juice, smoothies to coffee and bubble tea. For a quick take-away cup of coffee, the Merry Coffee station at the campus canteen is also a great choice.

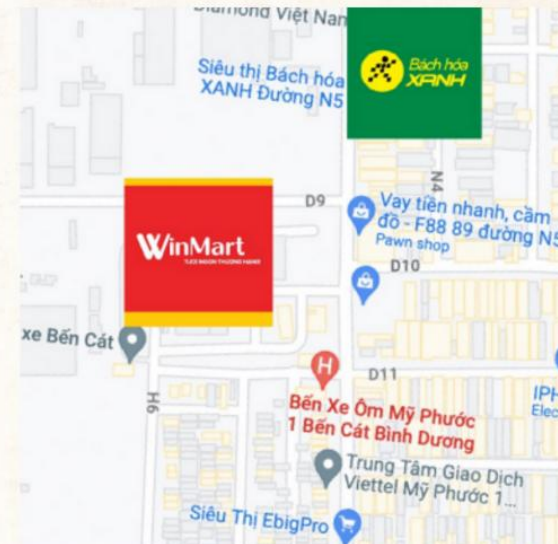

Health



- Health insurance not mandatory in Vietnam; acquired privately by students; recommended.
- Bring your yellow vaccine booklet with you.
- Vaccinations are not mandatory; check with an institute for tropical diseases or your MD.
- We recommend you bring your medicine from Germany, especially if you have to take it regularly.

Hospitals and doctors usually have equal international standards but may not speak English. But there are several private/international hospitals comparable to those standards with English speaking doctors like:

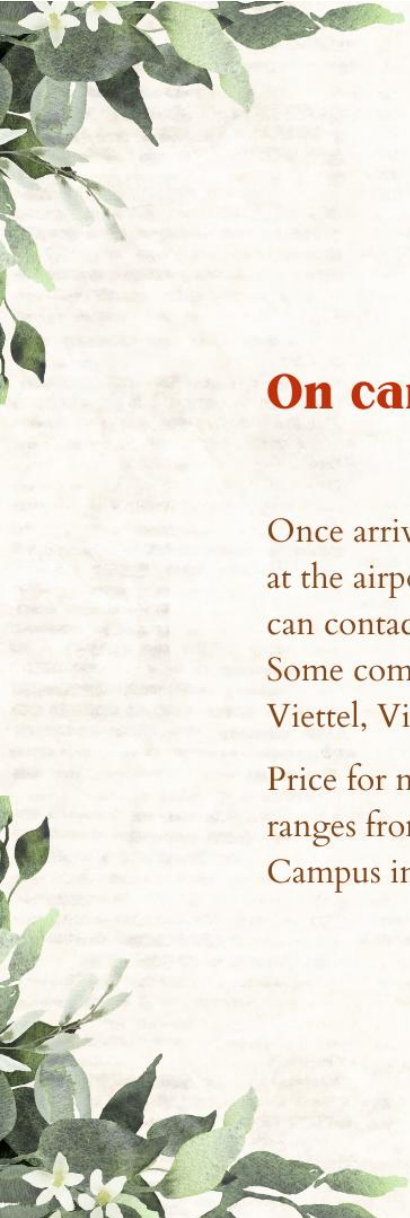

Internet services

On campus support

Once arriving in Vietnam, one should buy a SIM card directly at the airport, which usually costs about 300,000 VND or you can contact VGU staff for further information.
